William Alfred Braddock was born in Rifle, Colorado, in 1929. He earned a B.A. from the University of Colorado in 1951 and a Ph.D. from Princeton University in 1959. Braddock joined the staff of the USGS in 1952 and remained with the agency for his entire career, while also serving as an instructor, then professor, of geology at the University of Colorado (1956-1994). He was a member of the Geological Society of America and the American Geophysical Union. Braddock's primary area of research was the structural geology and igneous and metamorphic petrology of the Rocky Mountains, Colorado and Wyoming, and the Black Hills, South Dakota.
