Ralph Willard Imlay received his Ph.D. from the University of Michigan in 1933 and served on the staff of the USGS from 1940 until his retirement in 1970. He also worked as a Research Associate at the National Museum of Natural History from 1967 to 1989. Imlay was an outstanding expert on Jurassic systems in the North America and was President of the Paleontological Society in 1964 and 1965.
