Dredging and bathymetric surveys were conducted on the east-facing slope of the northeast rift zone of Tenchi seamount and in parts of the Jimmu and Suiko seamounts. USGS personnel involved in the project included Everett D. Jackson, Keith E. Bargar, Monte Marshall, and James V.A. Trumbull.
