Typed 94-page copy, with handwritten revisions, of a manuscript entitled "A Boat Trip Down Green River from Green River, Wyoming, to Green River, Utah", by Ralf R. Woolley. The manuscript is a popular account of a river trip made by the author as part of a cooperative mapping project involving the USGS, Utah Power and Light Company, the Colorado River Commission, and the Federal Power Commission. USGS personnel on the trip included party chief and topographic engineer K.W. Trimble, geologist J.B. Reeside, Jr., and the author (a hydraulic engineer). 1922.- Folder 2. Typed 60-page copy of a manuscript entitled "A Boat Trip Down Green River from Green River, Wyo. - Green River, Ut. July 10 - Sept. 14 - 1922.", by Ralf R. Woolley. This text is a final version of the manuscript in Folder 1, and is accompanied by an index map showing the Green River Basin in Wyoming, Utah, and Colorado. No date.- Folder 3. Typed, nine-page copy of a manuscript entitled "Diary of H. Elwyn Blake, Jr.", documenting a boat trip on the Green River from Green River, Wyoming, to Green River, Utah, August 2-19, 1926.- Folder 4. Typed, 15-page copy of a manuscript entitled "My Trip Down the Green River", by F. LeMoyne Page, documenting the trip made by Page, H.E. Blake (see Folder 3), and three others, August 2-19, 1926. None of the participants appear to have had any connection with the USGS.
